Discover and Experience the Treetop Walk

With a total distance of 1,350 meters (including the ramp in the tower), the Treetop Walk Usedom winds its way through the Heringsdorf forest. At heights of up to 23 metres, you walk through the island's typical beech and pine forest – past numerous learning and activity stations.

View Tower

In the truest sense of the word, the highlight of the treetop walk is the view tower. This is modelled on the old Bismarckwarte (Bismarck Observatory). The top viewing platform is 75 metres above sea level, and offers a unique view over the Kaiserbäder, the Baltic Sea coast and, in fine weather, even as far as the island of Rügen. An accessible net awaits those with a sense of adventure at this lofty height.

Wheelchair & Family-Friendly

The treetop walk and the view tower have a maximum gradient of 6%, making them easy to use with wheelchairs and prams alike. The wire fencing of the railing grants a free view of the surroundings.

By advance notification wheelchairs and wheeled walkers can be borrowed free-of-charge.

Please Note:

Bicycles, scooters, etc., are not permitted on the treetop walk.

Dogs & Pets

Dogs (and animals of all kinds) are not permitted on the treetop walk. There are boxes with drinking water available. Exception: Disabled companion and assistance dogs.

Shop

In our shop you can find regional specialities, sustainable products – made from wood, felt and other materials – and all sorts of souvenirs.

Around the Treetop Walk

The island of Usedom is one of the most popular holiday destinations on the Baltic Sea and is one of the sunniest regions in Germany.
